

Corporation of the City of Clarence-Rockland

By-law 2022-46

Being a by-law to authorize a Road Transfer Agreement between the United Counties of Prescott and Russell and the Corporation of the City of Clarence-Rockland.

Whereas Sections 8, 9, and 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25 and amendments thereto provides that every municipal corporation may pass by-laws for the purpose of governing its affairs as it considers appropriate; and

WHEREAS County Road Number 21 (St-Jean Street) and County Road Number 1 (St-Pascal Street) within the geographical boundaries of the United Counties of Prescott and Russell are highways within the meaning of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the "Act") under the jurisdiction of the County;

AND WHEREAS Baseline Road from Canaan Road to Joannis Road and Baseline Road from St-Jean Street (County Road 21) to County Road 8 (Landry Street) within the geographical boundaries of the City of Clarence-Rockland are highways within the meaning of the Act under the jurisdiction of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS County Council adopted resolution 2023-201 proposing transferring a portion of County Road 21, known as St-Jean Street, located in the City of Rockland and a portion of County Road 1 known as St-Pascal Road to the Municipality and receiving a portion of Baseline Road from the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS Council for the Municipality adopted resolution 2023-122 agreeing with the proposed road transfers as per the terms and conditions as indicated in the County Council resolution 2023-201.

AND WHEREAS section 52 of the Act authorizes the transfer of jurisdiction over a highway.

Now therefore the Council of the City of Clarence-Rockland enacts as follows:

1. That Municipal Council authorizes the Director of Operations to sign a Road Transfer Agreement between the United Counties of Prescott and Russell and the City of Clarence-Rockland, and all other documents as required to affect the provisions of such agreement;

2. That the agreement be in the form hereto annexed and marked as Schedule "A" to this by-law
3. That this by-law shall come into force on the day of its adoption.
