

# The Corporation of the City of Clarence-Rockland

## By-law 2026-31

Being a By-Law to amend the Fireworks By-law 2025-26 in order to provide for a new definition for Temporary Sales Unit.

Whereas the Fireworks By-law 2025-26 was adopted on March 19, 2025; and

Whereas Section 1.18 of the said by-law which describes Temporary Sales Unit as:

“an enclosed portable stand, cart, display rack, cargo container or trailer, or other display unit that can be moved from one location to another and is used for the sale of consumer fireworks. No temporary sales unit may remain in the same location for more than nine (9) consecutive days. A temporary sales unit does not include a motor vehicle as defined in the HighwayTraffic Act”.

was found to be in contradiction to section 3.8 which prohibits the sale of consumer fireworks from a temporary sales unit; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to amend Section 1.18, being the definition of “Temporary Sales Unit”;

Therefore, the Council of the City of Clarence-Rockland enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law 2025-26 be amended by replacing the definition under Section 1.18, with the following:

“Temporary Sales Unit” means an enclosed portable stand, cart, display rack, cargo container or trailer, or other display unit that can be moved from one location to another and is used for the sale of consumer fireworks. A temporary sales unit does not include a motor vehicle as defined in the HighwayTraffic Act.

2. This by-law shall come into full force and take effect on the date of its adoption.
