Specifically, we aim to:

- Increase accessibility by reducing or eliminating camp fees for families who may otherwise be unable to afford participation.
- Maximize participation by enabling a higher percentage of youth across all age groups to attend summer camp.
- Enhance program quality by investing in equipment, materials, and resources that support safe, engaging, and skill-building outdoor experiences.
- Improve safety and reliability of equipment by replacing aging or worn gear with newer, safer,

and more durable equipment that meets current standards.

- Promote inclusion and equity by ensuring that every member feels they belong and can fully participate alongside their peers.
- Strengthen youth development outcomes by providing opportunities to build leadership, independence, teamwork, and resilience in a real-world outdoor setting.

How will your organization be affected if the grant is not approved or if a reduced amount is granted?

If the grant is not approved, or if a reduced amount is granted, our organization will face important limitations in delivering a fully accessible and high-quality summer camp program.

Most significantly, financial barriers for families will increase, which may prevent some youth from attending camp altogether. This would directly impact participation levels and limit opportunities for those who would benefit most from the experience.

A reduced budget would also mean scaling back program elements, including fewer activities, limited resources, and reduced capacity to provide the full range of skill-building experiences we strive to offer.

In addition, we may need to delay or forgo the replacement of aging equipment, which could impact both the quality of activities and the overall safety and reliability of our gear.

Finally, the organization would need to rely more heavily on fundraising efforts and volunteer contributions to offset the shortfall, placing additional pressure on families, leaders, and the community.

Overall, without full funding, our ability to provide an inclusive, safe, and impactful camp experience for all youth would be significantly reduced.

We are seeking funding to support our summer camp program for all youth sections within our organization, ensuring that every participant has access to a safe, inclusive, and high-quality outdoor experience.

The grant funds would be used in the following ways:

- Participant support and fee subsidies: A portion of the funding will be allocated to offset camp fees for families facing financial barriers, helping ensure that all youth have the opportunity to attend regardless of their financial situation.
- Program materials and activity costs: Funds will be used to purchase supplies for camp programming, including outdoor skills equipment, educational materials, and resources needed to deliver engaging, hands-on activities.
- Equipment replacement and upgrades: We will replace aging or worn equipment—such as tents, cooking gear, and safety-related items—with newer, safer, and more reliable alternatives that meet current standards.
- Health and safety measures: A portion of the funding will support first aid supplies, safety equipment, and other resources necessary to maintain a secure environment for all participants.
- Logistical support: Funds may also help cover transportation and site-related costs to ensure smooth and accessible camp operations for all groups.

Overall, this grant will directly support our ability to deliver a well-organized, safe, and enriching summer camp experience, while reducing financial barriers and ensuring that our equipment and programming meet the highest standards.

For our members, the most immediate benefit will be increased access to summer camp. By reducing financial barriers, more youth will be able to participate, ensuring that no one is excluded due to cost. Participants will also benefit from a higher-quality camp experience, with improved programming, better resources, and access to newer, safer equipment.

The replacement of aging gear will lead to enhanced safety and comfort, allowing youth to fully engage in activities with confidence. Updated tents, cooking equipment, and safety supplies will improve both the reliability of our operations and the overall camp experience.

For volunteers and leaders, this funding will reduce logistical and financial pressures, allowing them to focus more on delivering meaningful programming rather than sourcing or compensating for limited resources. Improved equipment and materials will also make it easier to run activities efficiently and safely.

At an organizational level, the grant will strengthen our ability to deliver consistent, inclusive, and high-quality programming, while supporting long-term sustainability by investing in durable equipment and reducing reliance on ad hoc fundraising.
