## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CLARENCE-ROCKLAND

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2019-32**

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SIGNATURE OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE NATION MUNICIPALITY IN REGARDS TO THE ALLOCATION AND MANAGEMENT OF A NEW JOINT WATER SYSTEM.

**WHEREAS** Sections 8, 9, and 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25 and amendments thereto provides that every municipal Corporation may pass by-laws for the purpose of governing its affairs as it considers appropriate; and

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Clarence-Rockland intends to enter into an agreement with the Nation Municipality for the supply of potable water to Limoges; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed necessary to sign a memorandum of understanding with the Nation Municipality in order to define the general terms of the allocation and management of the new joint water system;

## NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CLARENCE-ROCKLAND ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Clarence-Rockland enacts as follows:

- **1. THAT** the Mayor the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign a Memorandum of Understanding to define the general terms for the allocation and management of the new joint water system between the City of Clarence-Rockland and the Nation Municipality to meet immediate and projected water demands in both municipalities; and
- **2. THAT** the memorandum of understanding be in the form hereto annexed and marked as Schedule "A" to this by-law;
- **3. THAT** this by-law shall come into force on the day of its adoption and shall remain in force until it is repealed.
